

The tension existing between divine will and mans free will is a major theme in epic poetry, present in the Greek epics, Virgils Aeneid, the Continental Renaissance epics, and Miltons Paradise Lost. The successful hero submits his will to the wills of the gods or God. Miltons treatment of human free will and his concept of heroism follow the epic tradition. The Puritan poet is not a rebel against the epic tradition as so many critics have affirmed.
